Starting on August 2, 2021, United ISD will now be using a new automated volunteer management program called App-Garden Volunteer Tracker to make the process easier for our volunteers. Individuals who seek to serve as volunteers must submit an online application (see instructions below) prior to beginning a volunteer activity. As part of the application process, all volunteers must attach the following documents (where applicable)

United I.S.D. Volunteer Tracker requires documents to be uploaded along with the application:

- 1.Current Valid Picture ID (Texas Driver's License, Texas ID, Official Passport)
 - o Current active UISD employees —current UISD issued ID only.

 Make sure you identify yourself as a UISD employee in the application.
- 2. DPS Computerized Criminal History Form Signed and dated o UISD Employees do not need this form to be attached.
- 3. TB Certificate of Examination -You can download UISD's document or provide it from your primary care provider

Process- Starting on August 2, the United ISD- Volunteer Tracker website will be available to register to become a UISD Volunteer. It will be located under the "Parents" tabs. The first time you access the system you will need to click on "New Registration" to register your email address, create a password, and create an account.
